## How Universities Help Firms Innovate & Perform Better in South Australia

Universities have been found to play an important role in facilitating SMEs to access knowledge for innovation purposes. This is significant for SMEs as they cannot base their competitiveness on a single type of knowledge, especially in highly competitive and complex markets. Despite South Australia having a high proportion of SMEs in its economy, research suggests that there are still significant barriers to university-SME collaboration. After presenting some of the latest research in university-SME collaborations in this lecture, Pi-Shen Seet and Matt Salier will discuss some of the latest initiatives that Flinders University has successfully introduced for different partnership contexts that are especially relevant for SMEs. They will present successful case studies of how firms have used these collaborations to improve their internationalisation efforts. This lecture invites those who wish to hear how their SME can capitalise on accessing the knowledge, resources and networks of universities to improve innovation capability and performance as well as policy makers and practitioners interested in or working in this critical area for South Australia.
