“ Intergovernmental bargaining is a mainstay in any federal system but it is not well understood. This lecture will highlight bargaining in the Australian commonwealth through COAG (involving the commonwealth and all the states and territories) and bilaterally where individual states negotiate with the commonwealth. The common denominator over time has been money – too little of it. But other factors can help understand us who wins and who loses including leverage, experience and party congruence. ”
