**Title:** 'Physical activity during a pandemic: an exploratory study of university students' physical activity during COVID-19'

# Researcher(s)

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#### Description of the study

This study is part of the project titled "Physical activity during a pandemic: an exploratory study of university students' physical activity during COVID-19". The study aims to use Photovoice, where participants photograph and reflect on their experiences, to explore students' experiences of physical activity during the various stages of the pandemic. This project is supported by Flinders University, College of Medicine and Public Health.

#### Purpose of the study

This study aims to find out about students' experiences of physical activity during the COVID-19 pandemic.

### What will I be asked to do?

Your involvement will include **taking daily photographs** (using a mobile phone or other digital camera) over a two-week period that represent your experiences of physical activity. You will then be asked to **upload your three photographs** that best represent your experiences, providing a



commentary on why you chose these photographs, to a dedicated FLO site. You will also be invited to complete an anonymous questionnaire exploring psychological wellbeing. The questionnaire can be completed online and will take around 10 minutes. Please note that photographs depicting other people can only be included if they are not identifiable (e.g., their face is blurred, or they can only be seen from behind). Photographs depicting illegal material or activities will not be accepted on the FLO site.

We will be hosting an online exhibition of photographs sharing students' experiences. You can elect to take part in the exhibition, anonymously if you choose. In addition, 20 students will be randomly selected to participate in focus group interviews (conducted online) to discuss their photos and experiences. Focus group participants will be provided with a \$20.00 Coles voucher in recognition of their participation time.

## What benefit will I gain from being involved in this study?

By participating in this study, you will have the opportunity to share your experiences of COVID-19 with the Flinders University community.

# Will I be identifiable by being involved in this study?

You will be identifiable to other project participants on the dedicated project FLO site, and if you choose, in the online photographic exhibition (your name will be linked only to your photographs, not your comments).

Any identifying information will be removed from the analysis of the photographs and commentary, and your comments will not be linked directly to you. All information and results obtained in this study will be stored in a secure way, with access restricted to relevant researchers.

### Are there any risks or discomforts if I am involved?

The researcher anticipates few risks from your involvement in this study, however, given the nature of the project, some participants could experience emotional discomfort when commenting on their experiences of COVID-19. ### How do I agree to participate?

Participation is voluntary. You may refuse to answer any questions, and you are free to withdraw the project at any time without penalty.
