
## NATIONAL RECONCILIATION WEEK 2018



## Guided tour of Colebrook Reconciliation Park

Between 1943 and 1972 some 350 Aboriginal children lived here at Colebrook House, taken and isolated from their families. There are now two sculptures on site, the "Fountain of Tears' and the 'Grieving Mother' by well-known South Australian artist Silvio Apponyi. They serve as a permanent memorial in remembrance of the Aboriginal children of the 'Stolen Generation' and their families.
