Letter of Introduction

Title: Transition to and first year of university for students on the autism spectrum.

This letter is to introduce Alison Nuske who is a PhD candidate in the College of Nursing and Health Sciences at Flinders University.

Alison is undertaking research leading to the production of a thesis or other publications on the subject of transition to and first year of university for students on the autism spectrum.
